Oasis Kids | Information Sheet

Who is in charge of Oasis Kids?

Pastor Jon Dixon and a team from New Minas Baptist are the leaders at Oasis Kids.

Where are you located?

Oasis Kids [nursery, preschool and elementary school] is located in Patterson Hall on the top level. Oasis Youth is located on the lower level. Patterson Hall is building #24 on the Acadia University map.

What times is Oasis Kids open?

We are open from 15 minutes before until 15 minutes after adult activities. This means we are open on <u>Thursday</u> from 145-425pm, 615-845pm; <u>Friday</u> from 830am - 1215pm, 300 – 445pm, 615 – 845pm; <u>Saturday</u> from 830am - 1215pm, 145 – 415pm.

What should my children bring?

To the **Oasis Nursery [age 0-2]**, please bring your own diaper supplies, snacks and a cup for your child.

To **Oasis Kids [age 3 – grade 6]** please have your children wear <u>footwear</u> which is appropriate for playing games [no flip flops], please put <u>sun screen</u> on your children each time before you drop them off, and please send them with their own labelled water bottle and please label any other supplies.

In addition, on Friday morning elementary school children will be travelling by bus to Aylesford Lake Beach & Park. This trip will involve swimming in a lifeguarded area as well as playing on a playground. Parents are responsible to change their children into swimsuits before we leave and back into regular clothing when we return to Acadia. Oasis Kids staff will not change children into or out of swimsuits.

What about Meal Times?

Your children eat their meals with you. Please **be prompt to pick them up**, and please **do not bring them back early**. It is important that our staff have the time to have a break and eat their meals.
